

PROCLAMATION

April 14, 2012 - Occoquan Clean Up Day

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Occoquan, a non-profit organization of local businesses and citizens, promote the preservation and the maintenance of the natural integrity of the Occoquan Watershed by increasing community awareness through public and private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Occoquan has designated Saturday, April 14, 2012, as Occoquan Clean Up Day in order to improve the physical landscape on both the Prince William County and Fairfax County sides of the Occoquan River; and

WHEREAS, Friends of the Occoquan has been cleaning up the Occoquan for the past 13 years, this being their 26th clean up event for the Occoquan Watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Occoquan Watershed is a major source for our local supply of potable water as well as contributing to the recreational, leisure and educational activities for the citizens of Prince William County; and

WHEREAS, Prince William County is pleased to join in increasing public awareness and community involvement to preserve the Occoquan Watershed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Prince William Board of County Supervisors does hereby proclaim April 14, 2012 as Occoquan Clean Up Day.
